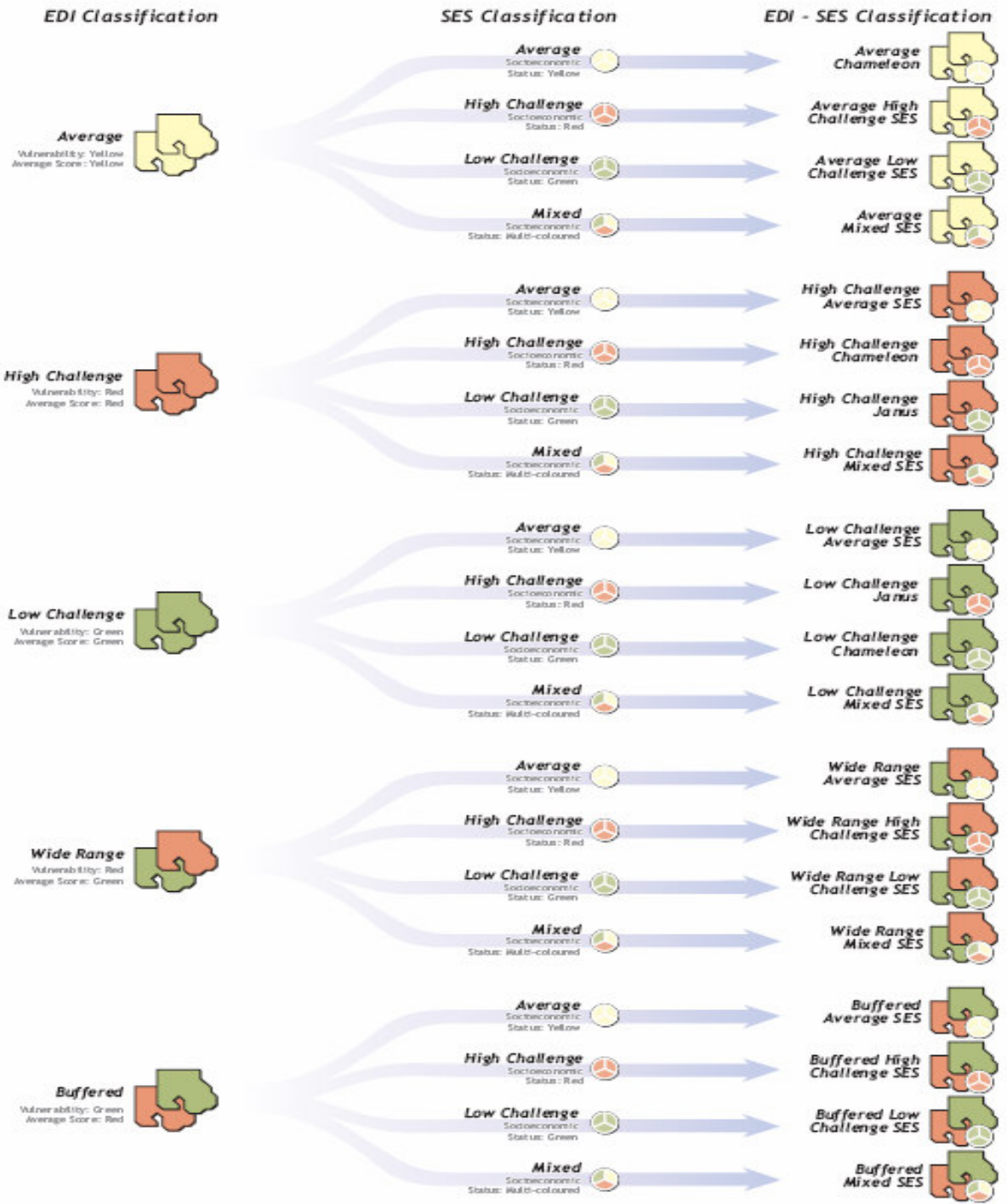
The amendment has also enabled another layer of research to be added using socioeconomic data

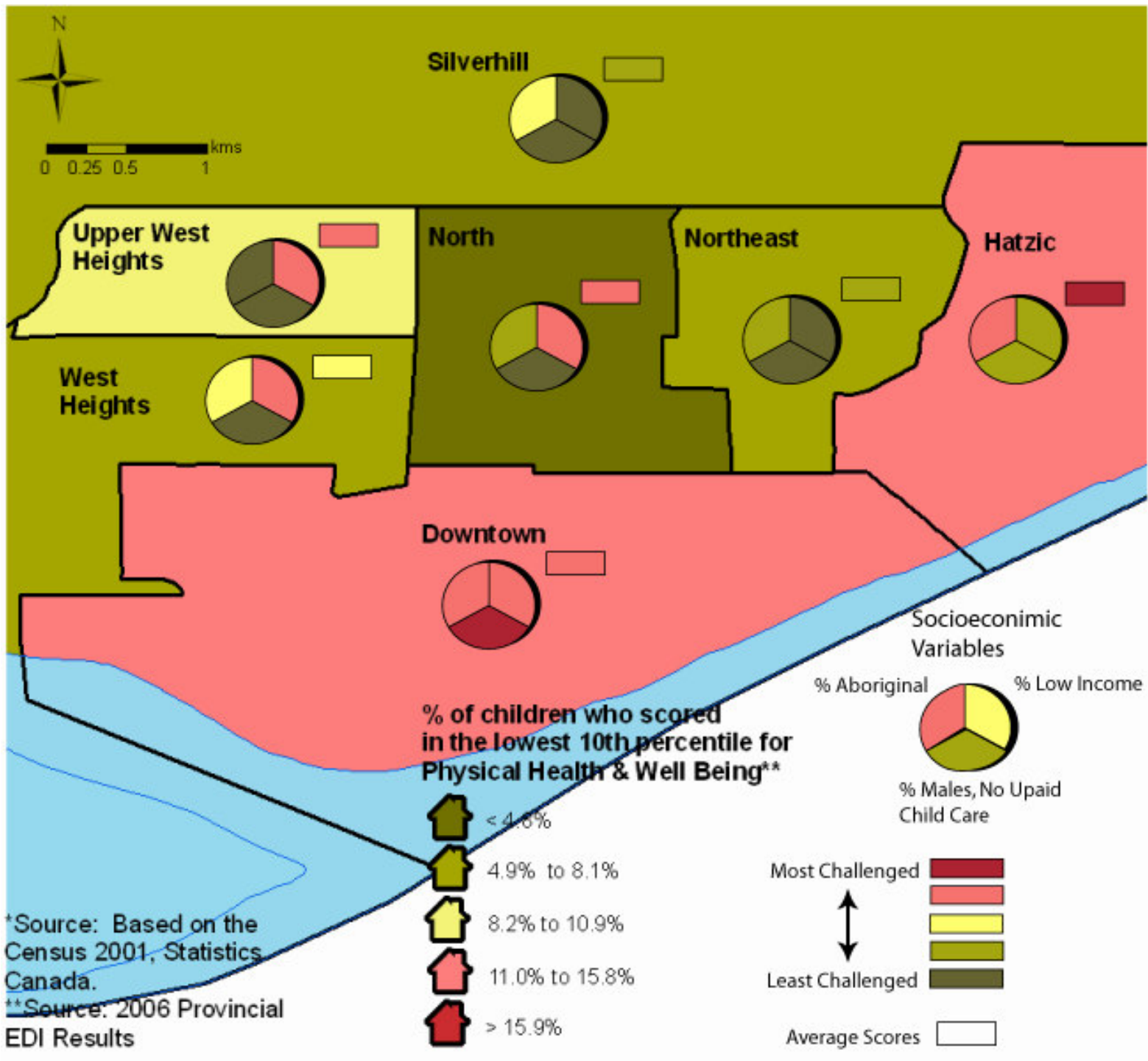
4 Factors That Influence Children's Development & Outcomes

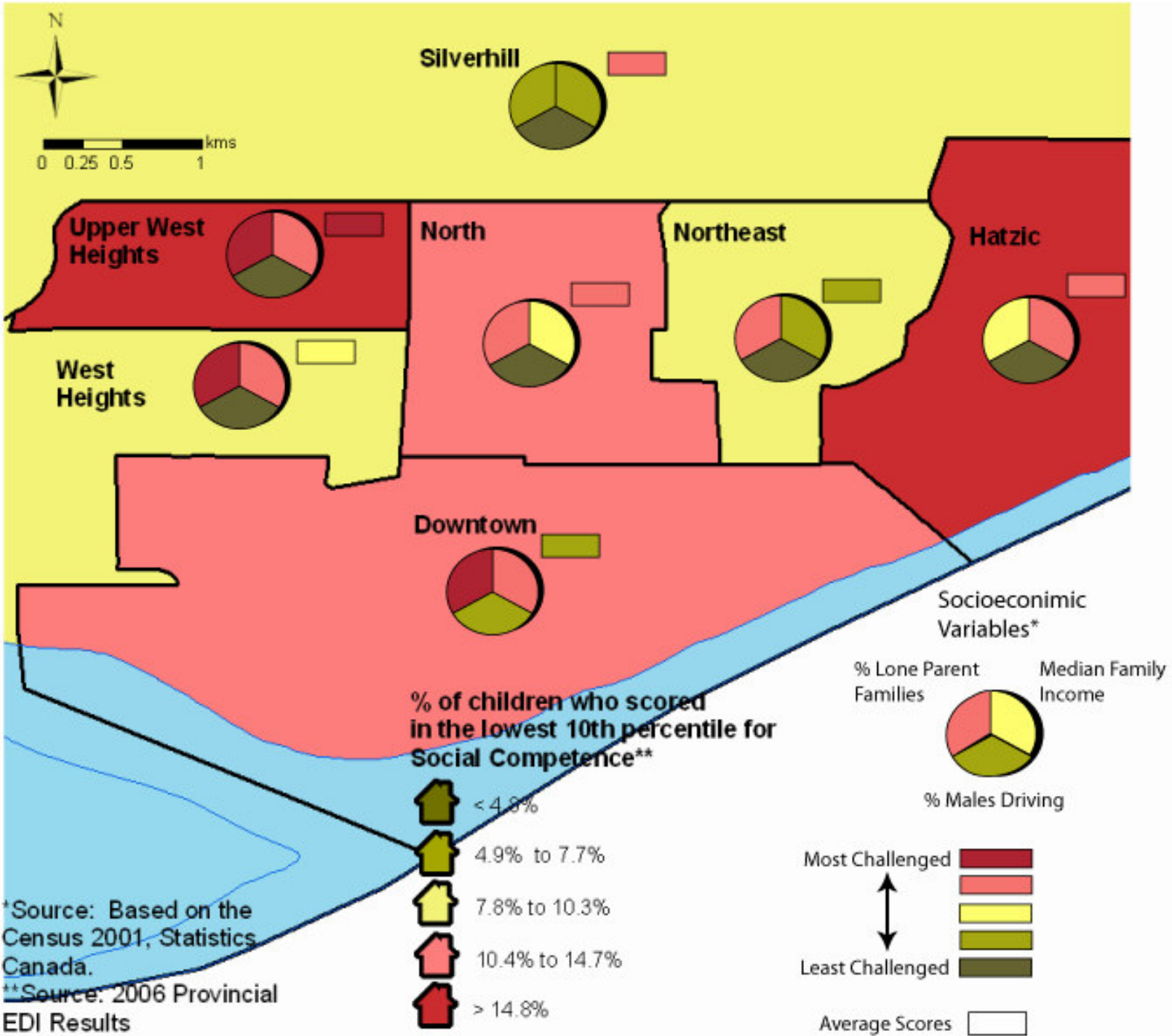
- What happens in the home - a child's biological predisposition; intimate relationships; family functioning
- What happens in the neighbourhood - neighbourhood structure and cohesion - Are neighbourhoods diverse culturally, socially and economically? Do residents 'feel' a sense of belonging and safety? Are neighbourhoods physically and socially traversable? Are neighbourhoods experiencing high growth and development?
- Services, supports and resources available (local) and accessible to families with young children - the funding and sustainability of programs; barriers to services, supports and resources; quality and coverage

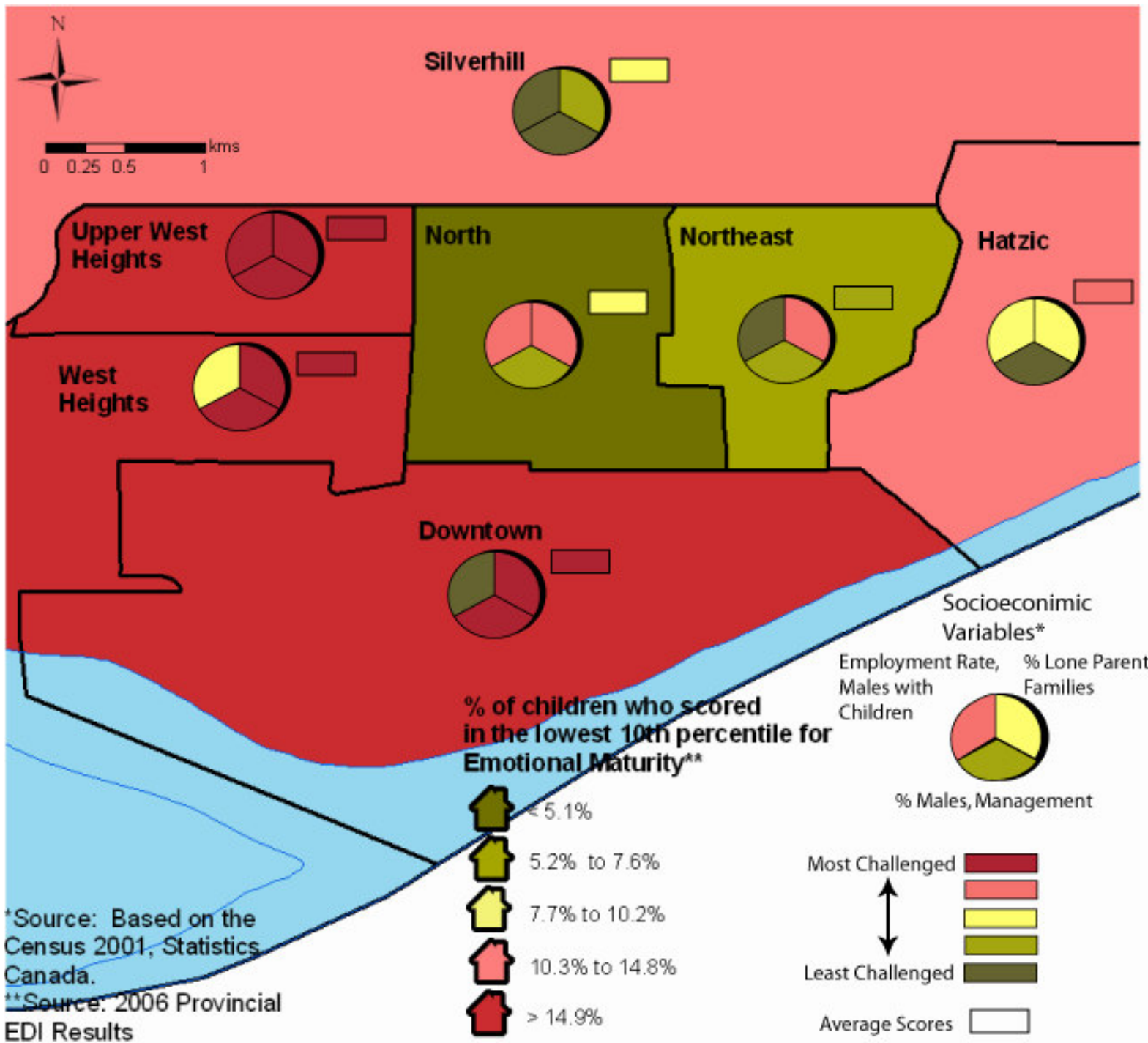
4 Factors That Influence Children's Development & Outcomes

- Socioeconomic Status (SES) - of families which are census variables used to predict the social, economic and cultural health of communities
- It is this factor (SES) that is one of the elements that will be discussed on the following maps



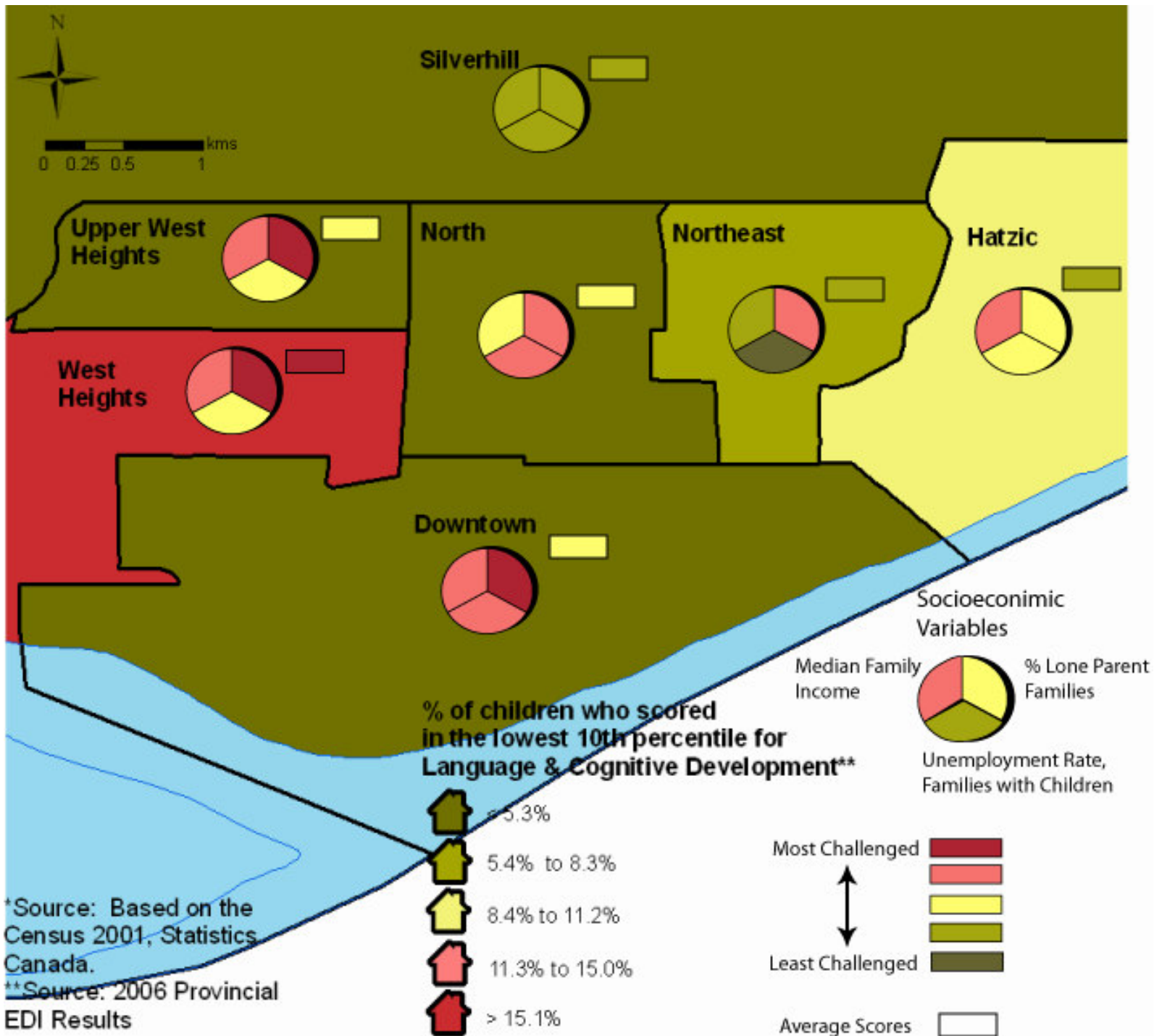
