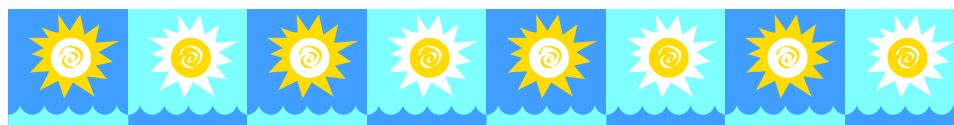

A community forum open to individuals in health care, social services, the school system, and all those who want to learn more or whose lives have been touched by FASD.

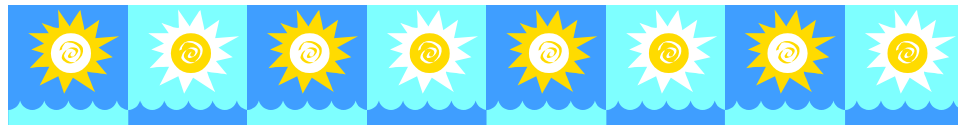
